What is the Transition to the Circular Economy?

The transition to the circular economy represents a significant shift from the traditional linear, take, produce, use, dispose' economic model to a more sustainable economic system that emphasizes the regeneration and reuse of materials and resources. In a circular economy, waste and pollution are minimized, and resources are kept in use for as long as





possible, creating a closed-loop system that promotes efficiency and sustainability.

This change requires a new approach in the design, production, use and disposal of products, influencing not only traditional business models but also the knowledge, skills and tools that organizations need to refer to in their operations.

The L2C Programme:

The L2C programme is structured in three modules, consisting of a total of ten units. Each unit comprises video lectures combined with practical activities, such as self-assessment exercises, tasks, simulations and case studies.

The topics addressed within the course have been carefully selected on the basis of feedback received in a survey, conducted on a sample of Italian Polish and German SMEs, thanks to which

it was possible to grasp the real needs, difficulties and requirements of companies that are undertaking this transition path, such as the basic principles and business models that characterise the circular economy; the regulatory framework regulating the circular transition at national, European and international level; and finally some models and best practices that can support SMEs leaders in the change path by drawing inspiration from practical cases of the challenges and successes faced by companies that have made the circular economy one of their pillars.
